At the exclusive RQFWS Grape Grazing by Night – Celebrating Australian Wine event next month, the general public has the rare opportunity to taste more than 1,800 wines, including the award-winners from the new vintage of season.

The RQWS is the first wine show of the season and the first to judge the 2016 vintage in Australia.

The evening will also provide wine enthusiasts with the rare opportunity to liaise with and learn from the expert winemakers and judges.

The RQWS endeavours to give Australian wineries exposure and helps promote the nation's diverse growing regions, passionate winemakers and their outstanding wines.
